# How to Sign-Up for a New York Public Library Card Using SimplyE

SimplyE is The New York Public Library's free e-reader app. The app is available on the App Store and Google Play. See below for instructions to sign up. To get the app, visit: [nypl.org/SimplyE](http://nypl.org/SimplyE)

### FOR ANDROID USERS:

- Download SimplyE on an Android device. **Location services must be enabled on your device.**
- Open the app and tap on the three lines in the upper left corner and go to "Settings," then "Accounts."
- Tap the plus sign in the upper right corner and add "The New York Public Library." At the bottom of the screen, it says "Don't have a library card? Sign Up?" Tap on "Sign Up."
- Confirm you are 13 or older and agree to have it access your location. This is necessary to determine if you are in New York.
- Fill in your home address, full name, and email address.
- Create a username and PIN.

### FOR IPHONE USERS:

- Download SimplyE on an iPhone device. **Location services must be enabled on your device.**
- Open the app and tap on "Settings" in the lower right corner and go to "Accounts," then "Add Library" and search for "The New York Public Library."
- In the middle of the screen, it says "Don't have a library card? Sign Up?" Tap on "Sign Up."
- Confirm you are 13 or older, tap to agree to the terms of the "End User License Agreement." Agree to have it access your location. This is necessary to determine if you are in New York.
- Fill in your home address, full name, and email address.
- Create a username and PIN.
